Racetrack tour 2009 – Baden-Baden



On this two-day training course, professional enduro riders will show you the right techniques and practices so that you can become a truly competent off-road rider. On both training days a sightseeing program in Rothenburg and Nuremberg awaits the pillion passengers.

Scouting Smoky Mountains 2009



Many riders enjoy the benefits of organised tours, but there are those who prefer a little unpredictability in their travel plans. Taking place from November to December 2009, take the opportunity to ride with Edelweiss to the 'world's end', visiting places along the way such as San Carlos de Bariloche, El Calafate, Torres del Paine and Ushuaia on your way south.
